- Parish Picnic Importance of addressing concerns some parishioners raised about the parish picnic format from last year and the cancellation of the 8am mass on the date of the picnic. Fr. Andy reiterated the main point of the picnic is to bring the whole parish together, not to remain divided by Mass attendance times. Recognition that a few parishioners may have some time constraints.
