Fr. John Donahue's long awaited study of the major themes of both the Old and New Testaments that bear on issues of social justice, e.g., creation; exodus; liberation; prophets; psalms and wisdom literature; Jesus and the Kingdom of God; Matthew and the heritage of Israel; Luke: Jesus as a Prophet who proclaims good news to the Poor; Paul: justification and community solidarity; and concluding reflections will be available in early December.

John R. Donahue, SJ, received his Ph.D. in New Testament from the University of Chicago, and is the Raymond E. Brown Distinguished Professor of New Testament Studies (emeritus) at St. Mary's Seminary and University, Baltimore, MD. He previously taught New Testament at the Vanderbilt Divinity School, at the Jesuit School of Theology in Berkeley, and at Loyola University, Maryland.
